Roy read the emails and no matters arising therefrom

3. FINANCIAL REPORT The Treasurer to tender his finance report. Roy read the Treasurers report in the absence of the Treasurer it was noted that there are some outstanding for Ulmarra expenses and BBQ expenses it was then moved and accepted.

4. GENERAL BUSINESS:

Registration of the Change of Public Officer details was lodged with the New South Dept of Services on the 20^{th} January 2020.

(i) New members – Letters of welcome have been forwarded to the five new members Ryland O'Connell No. 266, Tom Crozier No. 267, Bob Northam No. 268, Andre Cunin No. 269, Tony Williams No. 270

Esther Froesch (6th new member) has been reimbursed her subscription as she would be unable to travel to Ulmara.

(ii) Shed Policy is to be updated from 2017;

The shed policy dated 2017 is to be updated with two alterations that will come into force when the Ulmarra Shed is opened. A copy will be available at the General Meeting 29th February 2020.

(iii) Timber Milling and Sales Policy for comment and improvement and acceptance;

The existing draft policy is to be modified and the draft will be discussed with the timber millers prior to being made available to club members hopefully at the General Meeting on the 29th February 2020.

(iv) Status regarding the Ulmarra Shed such as building works and development application regarding the mezzanine level;

At the present time the Shed at Ulmarra is being cleaned and some storage items and equipment are being moved from Hoof Street to the shed at Ulmarra. Roy and Colin are carrying out this work usually on Wednesday and Thursday. There have been other members who have been helping with the stacking and cleaning of the Pigeon shed. Richard Nichols has donated a window and a glass sliding door to be used in the setup at Ulmarra. There was an email sent out to members as to whether anyone would be available to help with the move. There have been a number of volunteers but it would be useful to have more volunteers.

The Committee are making arrangements for the Council Inspector (Ray Phelps) for the Ulmarra area to attend the shed and discuss and advise what would be required and information for a Development Application to be lodged in relation to the construction of a mezzanine level and other alterations which the Committee want to implement.

(v) Item 4 of Agenda for Special Committee Meeting 16th January 2020 the establishment of an "Ulmarra Shed Committee" and invitation to CVWA members to assist in the transfer from Hoof Street to Ulmarra of machinery, timber and other CVWA assets.

Although the Committee have received offers to help with the move and works a Ulmarra Shed Committee still needs to be established.

(vi) Notice to Trevor Townsend of intention to vacate the South Grafton shed

Colin Lang has spoken with Trevor Townsend and advised that CVWA intend to vacate the sheds at South Grafton and will give written notice once a date has been decided. A letter will also be sent to Trevor thanking him.

(vii) Invitation to CVWA from the owner of the Cowper Gallery (Kerry Bowles) to be discussed regarding the Club staging an exhibition probably in June or July.

Further enquiries are going to be made regarding the invitation and will be brought to the members attention at the next general meeting.

It was also brought to the Committees attention that the works carried out at Jacaranda Park are now open to the community, but no thank you was extended to CVWA for those works and a Thank You should be passed onto Merve Smidt, Trevor Layland, John Phillipse, Max Lloyd, and to Brett who was a great help with his truck. Bob Montgomery should not be forgotten as he took care of a BBQ for the workers.
