| • Class 1 – Item of Furniture
A free standing or hanging article used in a house or room. e.g. table, chair, bed, mirror, desk, large chests, blanket boxes and the like etc. | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 2 - Item using Jacaranda Timber
An item of any construction in Jacaranda timber. | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 3 - Turned Article
An item which is mainly constructed on a lathe. | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 4 - Small Item
A small item is one which could, in the Steward's opinion, be fitted in a typical shoe box. | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 5 – Box of any Construction
A box of any construction not greater than 500mm in any dimension | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 6 – Functional Object
A functional item which does not necessarily qualify for classes 1, 3, 4 or 5. This may include toys, games, puzzles, musical instruments, models etc.,. | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 7 -Decorative Object
Any item which is principally a decorative or artistic item. This includes sculpture, intarsia, carved objects etc | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |
| • Class 8 -Novice
Any item by a club member who has not won any class at any previous exhibition. | 1st Prize \$100 | 2nd Prize \$50 |

The Notaras Trophy will be awarded to the CVWA member whose entry is judged to be 'Best in Competition'.

COMPETITION RULES

- Classes 1 to 7 are open to all members of the club and public.
- Class 8 is for CVWA members only. Open to any member who has not previously won first prize in any class of a previous CVWA competition.
- Entries by members must be labelled with the entrants CVWA membership number and an item number plus sale price (or NFS).
- Entries by non-members will be allocated a number by the committee. Entries by non-members may not be sold and shall be marked NFS.
- Entries not meeting these requirements will be removed from the competition.
- The committee, as it sees fit, may refuse any entry or assign an entry to a class other than that in which it was entered.
- In the event of a disagreement the committee's decision will be final.
- The Entry fee for non-club members \$10.00 per item, nil to members.
- Entry forms must be lodged no later than Saturday 18-Oct-2025
- Entrants shall be responsible for delivery and pick up of their entries.
- Entered items must be delivered to the competition venue (South Grafton Ex-Services Club Auditorium) by 10am, Friday 24 October 2025
- Entered items to be picked up between 1:00pm and 2:00pm, 2 November, 2025. Unless other arrangements have been made, entries not picked up at the allocated time may be held or disposed of by the Committee.
